The National Retirement Benefits Fund (the Fund) was established on 1 July 2012 for the private sector, church denominations and public enterprises. The Fund operates on the basis of defined contributions and it collects compulsory contributions from employees and employers towards their retirement.

The Fund operates under the provisions of the National Retirement Benefits Scheme Act 2010; National Retirement Benefits Scheme (Administration) Regulations 2012; National Retirement Benefits Scheme (Amendment) Act 2014; and the National Retirement Benefits Scheme (Appointment of Directors) Regulations 2015.

The Fund owns shares in Tonga Development Bank (TDB) and Pacific Timber & Hardware (PTH) Limited. The Fund also manages the Government Social Welfare Scheme on behalf of the Tonga Government.

# CHAIRMAN'S REPORT



I am pleased to present the Annual Report 2019/2020 of the National Retirement Benefits Fund (Fund). Despite the challenges brought by the Covid-19 and Tropical Cyclone Harold, the Fund had a successful year and was still able to pay the retirement fund benefits and meet the needs of its members and stakeholders.

The Fund faced the challenge of members' increased withdrawal of their funds due to redundancies and hardship. The impact was felt mostly in businesses that were downsized or closed down in the tourism and related sectors which resulted in a temporary decrease of members' contributions.

During the first onset of Covid-19, the Board kept emphasizing the importance of retirement savings, maintain discipline and not to release the funds unnecessarily. A fundamental challenge has been to manage the expectations of our members and stakeholders and protect the Fund's reputation. It was encouraging that despite all these challenges, the remaining members were vigilant to continue their contributions to sustain the Fund and to reach \$11.41 at the end of the year.

The interest declared was 3.69 percent (%), a slight increase from 3.40% of last year due to returns from new investment in the PTH through acquisition of shares and ongoing investment in the TDB. Limited investment opportunities in the domestic market continued to be a major challenge.

In July 2019 the Patron of the Social Welfare Program, HRH Latufuipeka Tuku'aho presented cash donations to top-up the elderly's stipends for one month, to mark the 60<sup>th</sup> birthday of His Majesty, King Tupou VI.




The Fund will continue to place investment as a priority to achieve improved retirement outcomes for its members and it will also review the Acts, Policies and Strategies to protect and grow its members' savings. The challenge for the Board now is to ensure that members' contributions are invested to generate consistent and better returns. As the Fund consistently receive low interests from commercial banks, it has taken a more active investment approach by considering loans with good return projects.

The outlook for 2020/2021 will also be challenging due to Covid-19 however, we would like to assure members that as custodians of your funds, we are committed to sustain the Fund and to ensure that members' retirement is secure.

I would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge and thank our members, employers, Tonga Government and stakeholders for your assistance and support. I am grateful to my fellow Directors for their contributions and dedication to the Fund. Lastly, I thank the staff for their cooperation and support during this difficult year.

# CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT



I present the Fund's 2019/2020 Annual Report of the Fund with great respect. The report explains the achievements of the Fund despite the unsettling impacts of Covid-19 and Tropical Cyclone Harold.

The Fund continued to grow in terms of membership and contributions at a lesser pace than last year. The membership increased by 6.3 percent (%) to a total number of 15,425. The total contributions increased by 3.3 percent (%) to \$11.4 million and the investment income increased by 31.1 percent (%) to \$1.93 million. Similar to previous years, all investment income earned has been distributed to members.

The Fund has recorded for the first time investments in the Tonga Development Bank (TDB) and Pacific Timber & Hardware Limited (PTH) at fair value. This change resulted in significant valuation gains of \$0.69 million. Such changes in investment valuations would be a major source of volatility in the future.

The Fund managed its liquidity levels to meet regulatory requirements despite the uncertainty of Covid-19. The Fund paid \$4.43 million to members who have either became redundant or had financial hardship in addition to normal retirement and migration. Huge payments to members were made in April, May and June 2020.

The government addressed many of the challenges caused by the dual shocks of Covid-19 and Cyclone Harold by implementing a number of initiatives that benefitted some of our members. The Fund assisted government in supporting the implementation of wage subsidies and financial support to formal and informal businesses.

The Fund continued to maintain its administration costs below the mandated 2 percent (%) Management Expenditure Ratio (MER) benchmark and a great achievement was made when MER reached 1.4 percent (%) compared to 1.8 percent (%) last year.

The Fund continued to provide services for the implementation of the Government Social Welfare Scheme through timely payment of monthly stipends. During the year \$4.45 million was paid to 4,131 elderlyies. Due to Covid-19 and its guidelines, the Fund has started to disburse the stipends through bank accounts of the elderlyies or the carers.

I am deeply grateful to the Board for their assistance and guidance to me. I would like to thank the staff for their commitments and cooperation. Finally to our members and employers, we thank you for your support and contributions during this difficult year.

## Board

The functions and powers of the Board are defined in the NRBS Act 2010 and Amendment Act 2014. The Board of Directors consist of three representatives of employees, three representatives of employers, and one independent director with relevant experience and qualifications, who is nominated by the Chairman. The Directors' tenure is three years and renewable and directors are, nominated from churches, private businesses, and public enterprises and statutory boards.

The current Directors are: Rev. Dr. Tevita Havea (Chairman), Mrs. 'Alisi Taumoepeau (Deputy Chairlady), Rev. Dr. Tu'ipulotu Katoanga, Mr. Alfred Cowley and Mr. John Paul Chapman. Nomination of representatives from public enterprises and statutory boards is still pending due to a Cabinet decision of the previous government. The Board met seven times during the year.

## Board Committees

The main function of the committees is to provide technical advice to the Board. The Investment Committee met six times. The sub-committee met twice in June 2020 to discuss the staff remuneration and the assessment of the CEO's performance.

## Other Boards

The CEO represented the Fund in the TDB and PTH Board. Sesilia Halaholo, the Finance Manager also represented the Fund at some meetings in the TDB Board as the Alternative Director.

## Audit

The audit of the Fund's financial statements for the first six months was done by the external auditor, JK Chartered Accountants. The audit will be completed in October.

## Prudential Supervision

Under the Microfinance Institutions Act in 2019, the Fund has provided monthly financial reports to the National Reserve Bank of Tonga (NRBT).

## Policy Development

The Fund reviewed certain policies to strengthen governance and to align to existing requirements of the Fund and legislation. The Board approved a revision to the Financial Hardship Policy by limiting the hardship entitlement payment to \$2,000 for the first application. This is to ensure that the retirement fund is maintained at a sustainable level.

## OPERATIONS

### Members

The total members registered and contributed to the Fund continued to grow over time. On the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020, this number was recorded at 15,425, a 6 percent (%) increase from last year's total members of 14,503.



### Contribution

Total contributions collected were \$11,484,904.23, an increase of 4 percent (%) over last year's collection of \$11,041,121.16; attributed mainly to the increase in the total number of members and business compliance checks. The voluntary fund collected was \$329,416.54.


### Total Members Fund

The total balance for all members' accounts increased by 18.1 percent (%) from \$50,529,781.08 to \$59,406,672.31.



### Employers

By the end of June 2020, the total number of employers registered was recorded at 825 which is a 8 percent (%) increase compared to the 767 total recorded in June 2019.

Majority of total employers of 825 registered and contributed to the Fund comprised of 774 privately owned businesses employing 10,878 members, 29 Public Enterprises and Statutory Boards with 2,505 members, and 22 Churches with 2,042 employees.

**Fig.2: Number of Employers by Sector****Fig.3: Number of Members by Sector**


## Retirement Benefit Payments



A total number of 773 members withdrew some or all of their retirement funds under the various grounds permitted by the Act. This is an increase of 55 percent (%) compared to last year of only 499 members. The total amount of benefits withdrawn by those members amounted to \$4,275,435.87, an increase of 106 percent (%) from \$2,074,099.86 of last year. The steep increase was due to increased number of redundancies because of Covid-19 leading to a withdrawal of \$1,744,630.93 million of 39 percent (%) of the total amount withdrawn.


**Fig.4: Total Retirement Benefit Payments from 2016 - 2020**

## **Self- Managed Life Insurance Scheme**

With the premium rate of \$18.48 per active member for the sum insured of \$5,000, the Fund's Self-Managed Life Insurance is the most affordable across the country. This is an increase of 10 percent (%) from the \$16.80 per member last year.

The total benefit payment under death claims for 31 members amounted to \$155,000. The Act permits members to nominate a beneficiary to claim his retirement entitlements upon death, while in service and the age is under 70 years. The graph below shows increasing amount of Life Insurance paid over the years.

## **Enforcement and Compliance**

The Fund continued to participate in the government's Taskforce with the sole responsibility of enforcing compliance from both employers and members to the Fund's Act, Regulations and Policies. The Enforcement team continued to follow up the unregistered businesses to ensure employers are not only registered but also comply with the requirements of the Act.

## **INVESTMENT**

### **Investment Portfolio**

The Fund's total investment portfolio increased from \$48,045,679.98 in 2019 to \$56,760,189.62. This is an increase of \$8,714,509.64 or 18.1 percent (%) from the previous year due mainly to increased contributions from salary increase, improved compliance, more business registrations and re-valuation of equity investments.

### Fixed Interest

The new term deposits amounted to \$4,017,662.24, an increase of 9.9 percent (%) from \$40,545,679.98 in 2019 to \$44,563,342.22. These term deposits were all invested in the TDB due to their competitive interest rate. The rest of the term deposits are still invested in TDB, BSP, MBF, and government bonds.

### Equity

The Fund has received dividends from TDB and PTH.

In December 2019, Pacific Retail Limited (PRL owns PTH) and the Fund agreed on a 20% shareholding purchase in PTH Limited for TOP\$4,000,000. This is part of the divestment strategy for the Fund and for PRL's succession planning process.

The Fund Investment Committee managed the due diligence process with their advisors from Simmons Corporate Finance and Wayne Madden for PTH Limited and Eriksens Global Ltd for the Fund, both from New Zealand. In compliance to the NRBS Act 2010 Section 8.8, John Paul Chapman, a member of the Board did not participate in the discussions on the matter, in order to avoid any potential conflict.


A dividend policy was agreed to be a minimum 8% dividend yield of the original investment and 50% of Net Profit after Tax. This ranks as a superior investment return than what the Fund currently earns in today's investment market. The Fund has 20% of the voting shares in PTH Limited and is represented on the PTH Limited Board by its CEO, one of five Directors in PTH Limited.



## **Investment Income**

The total investment income was recorded at \$1,937,936.90 compared to \$1,477,969.03 in 2019, which is an increase of 31.1 percent (%) with a total of \$459,967.97. The huge growth was due to dividends collected from equity shares and increased number of matured term deposits. Normally the interests are collected and the principal amounts are rolled over except the term deposits in MBF due to its highly competitive rate.


**Fig.7: Investment Income 2016 - 2020**



## **Fund Earning Rate**

The Fund's Earning Rate was 3.69 (%) compared with 3.41 percent (%) at the end of 2019. This is an increase by 8.2 percent (%) which reflects the increased investment income earned during the year.

## **COMPLYING SCHEME**

Under the Act, the Complying Schemes were exempted with certain conditions. Out of the fifteen complying schemes that were originally approved, only eight remain. They are Tonga Power Limited, Tonga Gas Limited, Pacific Energy SW Limited, Electricity Commission, United States Peace Corps Tonga, E.M Jones Limited, National Reserve Bank of Tonga, and the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.



## **INFORMATION COMMUNICATION & TECHNOLOGY**

ICT division continued to review the Funds' information systems to ensure it remains in alignment with regulatory framework, policies and operational requirements of the Fund.

FMS (Fund Management System) were regularly assessed and updated to meet the ongoing requirement of the operations of the Fund with the aim to deliver its services to its members effectively and efficiently.

### **Systems Upgrade**

New hardware and software platforms were bought to host the Fund's critical services of its Database, Active Directory, File Servers, and including its critical applications such as FMS and MYOB.



### **ICT Contingency Plan Implementation**

The Fund has started to execute its latest 2019 contingency plan including daily, weekly, monthly and annual procedures for a full recovery from any natural or technical disasters and to ensure they are well in place and tested routinely.

### **Security**

The security systems particularly it's installation of 4 CCTV cameras within the premises have been upgraded to improve security at all times.

## **HUMAN RESOURCES**

### **Staff Number**

The Fund had a total staff of 30 with 28 permanent and 2 temporary staff.

## **GOVERNMENT SOCIAL WELFARE SCHEME**

The Fund continued to administer the Social Welfare Scheme for the elderly people age 70 and older on behalf of the Government of Tonga. The elderlies were fortunate to receive additional funds to top up their monthly stipends. First, the Patron of the Social Welfare Program, Princess Latufuipeka Tuku'aho HRH presented cash donations to top-up the elderlies' stipends for one month to mark the 60<sup>th</sup> birthday of His Majesty, King Tupou VI. Due to Covid-19, the government approved the payment of \$100 to each elderly as one-off payment and to start the advance payment each month instead of paying in arrear of the stipends.

The table below shows the number of elderlies and amount paid during the year by station. The next table also shows the number of elderlies by age group by station. By end of the year 4,131 elderlies received \$4,452,466.10.

## **1. Statement of Significant Accounting Policies**

---

### **Reporting Entity**

The National Retirement Benefits Fund (the "Fund") is a defined contribution superannuation fund domiciled in Tonga. The address of the Fund's registered office is at Vaha'akolo Road, Nuku'alofa.

The Financial Statements are for the National Retirement Benefits Fund established under Section 7 of National Retirement Benefits Scheme Act 2010. The National Retirement Benefits Fund administers the Retirement Benefits Fund in accordance with the provisions of National Retirement Benefits Scheme Act 2010 and National Retirement Benefits Fund Amendment Act 2014 and thus responsible for the management and investment of the fund.

The financial statements were authorized for issue by the Board of Directors on **02<sup>nd</sup> October 2020**.

### **Basis of preparation**

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis, and the accounting policies have been applied consistently throughout the year.

### **Statement of compliance**

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the National Retirement Benefits Scheme Act 2010, and generally accepted accounting practice as represented by International Financial Reporting Standard (IFRS).

### **Presentation currency**

The consolidated financial statements are presented in Tongan Pa'anga.

### **Other changes in accounting policies**

There have been no changes in the Fund's accounting policies since the date of the last audited financial statements.

### **Critical accounting estimates and judgements**

### **Comparative figures**

Comparative information has been reclassified as appropriate to achieve consistency in disclosure with the current year.

### **Summary of significant accounting policies**

The accounting policies that materially affect the measurement of the Statement of Financial Position, Statement of Comprehensive Revenue and Expense, Statement of Movement in Equity and Statement of Cash Flows are set out below.

**(a) Foreign currency translation and measurement**

The financial statements have been prepared and presented in Tongan Pa'anga. Foreign currency transactions are translated into Tongan Pa'anga (the functional currency) using the exchange rates prevailing at the dates of the transaction.

**(b) Property, plant and equipment**

The Fund does not have any property assets. All plant and equipment are measured at cost less depreciation and impairment.

**Additions and Subsequent costs**

The cost of an item is recognised as an asset or costs incurred subsequent to initial recognition are capitalised only when it is probable that future economic benefits or service potential associated with the item will flow to the Fund and the cost of the item can be measured reliably.

**Disposals**

Gains and losses on disposals are determined by comparing the proceeds with the carrying amount of the asset. Gains and losses on disposals are reported net in the surplus or deficit.

**Depreciation**

Depreciation is calculated using the straight-line method to allocate their cost to their residual values over their estimated useful lives, as follows

Items with a life expectancy of less than one year or cost less than \$500.00 are considered to be consumable items.

**Impairment of non-financial assets**

Assets held at cost that have a finite useful life is reviewed for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate that the carrying amount may not be recoverable. An impairment loss is recognised for the amount by which the asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount. If an asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount; the asset is regarded as impaired and the carrying amount is written down to the recoverable amount. The total impairment is recognised in the surplus or deficit. Non-financial assets other than goodwill that suffered impairment are reviewed for possible reversal of the impairment at each reporting date.

## **Financial assets**

Financial instruments comprise investments in equity, government and other fixed interest securities, term deposits, trade and other receivables, cash and cash equivalents, loans and advances, and trade and other payables. The Fund classifies their financial assets in the following categories: at fair value through profit or loss, held to maturity, loans and receivables and available for sale. The classification depends on the purpose for which the financial assets were acquired. Management determines the classification of its financial assets at initial recognition.

Financial instruments are recognised initially at fair value plus, for instruments not at fair value through profit or loss, any directly attributable transaction costs. Subsequent to initial recognition

Non-derivative financial instruments are measured as described below.

### *(a) Financial assets at fair value through profit or loss*

This category has financial assets that are designated at fair value through profit or loss at inception. This largely consists of equity investments which are managed and evaluated on a fair value basis in accordance with the Fund's investment policy and reported by key management personnel on that basis. Upon initial recognition, attributable transaction costs are recognised in profit or loss when incurred. Subsequent to initial recognition, financial instruments at fair value through profit or loss are measured at fair value, and changes therein are recognised in the profit or loss.

### *(b) Held to maturity financial assets*

Held-to-maturity investments are non-derivative financial assets with fixed or determinable payments and fixed maturities that the Fund's management has the positive intention and ability to hold to maturity, other than those that meet the definition of loans and receivables.

These are initially recognised at fair value including direct and incremental transaction costs and measured subsequently at amortised cost, using the effective interest method. Amortised cost is calculated by considering any discount or premium on acquisition and fees that are an integral part of the effective interest rate. The amortisation is included in interest income in the profit or loss. The losses arising from impairment of such investments are recognised in the profit or loss. Term deposits, government securities and other fixed interest securities are included under this category.

### *(c) Loans and receivables*

Loans and receivables are non-derivative financial assets with fixed or determinable payments that are not quoted in an active market. Subsequent to initial recognition, loans and receivables are measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method, less any impairment losses. Loans and advances, cash and cash equivalents and trade receivables are included under this category.

### **Impairment of financial assets carried at amortised cost**

The Fund assesses at each financial year end whether there is objective evidence that a financial asset or group of financial assets is impaired. A financial asset or a group of financial assets is impaired and impairment losses are incurred only if there is objective evidence of impairment as a result of one or more events that occurred after the initial recognition of the asset (a 'loss event') and that loss event (or events) has an impact on the estimated future cash flows of the financial asset or group of financial assets that can be reliably estimated.

### **(c) Revenue Recognition**

#### *Contributions*

Contributions from employers and members are recorded when control of the asset is ascertained which is upon receipt of the contribution schedule forms from the employers and the registration of the forms by the Fund. The Fund does not accrue for contributions for which no contribution schedule forms are received or received but not registered as it is not able to reliably estimate the contributions balance.

#### *Interest income*

Interest income is earned from investments such as government securities, other fixed securities, loans and advances and term deposits. Interest income is recognised using the effective interest rate method.

#### *Movement in fair value of investments*

Changes in the fair value of investments (including investment property) are recognised as income/(loss) and are determined as the difference between the fair value at year end or consideration received (if sold during the year) and the fair value as at prior year end or cost (if the investment was acquired during the period).

#### *Grants income*

Revenue from grants includes grants given by government organisations, their affiliates and third-party agencies. Grants are recognised when they become receivable unless there is an obligation in substance to return the funds if conditions of the grant are not met. If there is such an obligation, the grants are initially recorded as income received in advance and recognised as revenue when conditions of the grant are satisfied.

Other revenue is recognized when it is received.

### **(d) Contribution Account and Rate**

A Member must contribute to his Account five (5) per cent (%) of his annual salary applicable at the July Review Date. This is stated in the financial statement as Members Contribution Account.

The Employer must contribute to the Members Account seven and a half (7.5) percent (%) of the Member's annual salary, effective on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017. This is stated in the financial statement as Employers Contribution Account.

A Member may contribute additional amounts at such rate and amount as the Member determines. This is stated in the financial statements as Members Voluntary Contribution.

An Employer may contribute additional amounts at such rate and amount as the Employer determines. This is stated in the financial statements as Employers Voluntary Contribution.

Any individual who wishes to join the Benefits Fund may register and contribute at such rate and amount as he or she determines. This is stated in the financial statements as Voluntary Contributors Contribution.

**(e) Investment in joint ventures and associates**

*Joint Ventures*

A joint venture is a binding arrangement whereby two or more parties have joint control and the parties that have joint control of the arrangement have rights to the net assets of the arrangement. The financial statements include NRBF's joint interest in jointly controlled entities, using the equity method, from the date that joint control commences until the date that joint control ceases. Under equity method, on initial recognition the investment in a joint venture is recognised at cost, and the carrying amount is increased or decreased to recognise the NRBF's share of the profit or loss of the joint venture after the date of acquisition.

*Associates*

An associate is an entity over which the NRBF has significant influence (20% or more voting power and Board representation) and that is neither a subsidiary nor an interest in a joint venture. Associates are accounted for using the equity method, from the date that the power to exert significant influence commences until the date that the power to exert significant influence ceases. Under equity method, on initial recognition the investment in an associate is recognised at cost and the carrying amount is increased or decreased to recognise NRBF's share of the profit or loss of the associate after the date of acquisition.

**(f) Trade receivables**

Trade receivables are recorded at the amount due, less any provision for uncollectability.

**(g) Cash and cash equivalents**

Cash and cash equivalents comprise cash balances and call deposits. Bank overdrafts that are repayable on demand and form an integral part of the Fund's cash management are included as a component of cash and cash equivalents for the purpose of the statements of cash flows. Cash and cash equivalents are categorised as loans and receivables under financial assets.

**(h) Employee entitlements**

*(a) Wages and salaries and leave*

Employee benefits that are due to be settled within 12 months after the end of the period in which the employee renders the related service are measured at nominal values based on accrued entitlements at current rates of pay. These include salaries and wages accrued up to balance date, annual leave earned to but not yet taken at balance date, and any other leave entitlements.

*(b) Other entitlements*

The Fund pays increments to employees based on performance of the Fund and achievement of individual objectives by the employees. The Fund recognises a provision where contractually obliged or where there is a past practice, subject to performance evaluation.

**(i) Payables and deferred income**

Short term payables are recorded at their face value.

**(j) Provisions**

A provision is recognised for future expenditure of uncertain amount or timing when the Fund has a present legal or constructive obligation because of past events; it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation; and the amount has been reliably estimated. Provisions are not recognised for future operating losses.

Provisions are measured at the present value of the expenditures expected to be required to settle the obligation.

**(k) Members accrued benefits**

The liability for accrued benefits is the Fund's present obligation to pay benefits to members and beneficiaries. They are determined on the basis of the value of the contributions plus interest on investments, which arise from membership of the Fund up to the reporting date.

**(l) Grants**

The Grants and funding from Donor Funding Agencies have been recognized and accounted for under the Income Approach.

**(m) Taxation**

The National Retirement Benefits Fund income, including investment earning, is exempted from income tax and any other government impost (except consumption tax) under Section 13 of the National Retirement Benefits Scheme Act 2010.

**(n) Retirement Benefit and Voluntary Contributor's Payment Recognition**

Retirement Benefits and Voluntary Contributors Payments to Members are recognized at the time of payment.

**(o) Members Insurance Premium**

All Members' are insured on a Group Life Insurance Scheme which is self-managed by the National Retirement Benefits Fund with effect on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2012. The insured amount is fixed at \$5,000.00 per member.

**(p) Insurance Fund**

The Insurance policy for self-managing the group life insurance scheme and general insurance for motor vehicles has been adopted and is to be reviewed from time to time.

Receipts and payments are processed directly from the fund, and any excess of fund assets over the liabilities are reported separately in the Statement of Comprehensive Revenue and Expense. Each transaction is recognized at the time of payment.

**(q) Voluntary Contributors Accumulated Fund**

Voluntary Contributors Accumulated Fund was established to account for members who wish to contribute to their retirement benefit account.

The contribution revenue and payments are accounted for in the Statement of Changes in Net Assets Available for Benefits as Voluntary Contributors Contribution Account and Voluntary Contributors Benefits Payments respectively. The balances are transferred to the Voluntary Contributors Accumulated Fund Account at the end of the financial year.







**Fakatātā 1: Tokolahi 'o e Kau Pule Ngāue'anga mo e Kau Memipa mei he 2016-2020**










Fakatātā 7: Pa'anga Hū mai mei he 'Inivesimeni 2016 - 2020

Kapau na'a mau mai'u ha ngaahi fehalaaki fakafika 'a ia ne 'ikai fakatonutonu, na'e pau ke mau lave ki ai 'i he fakahā 'emau fakakaukaú .

Ko e ngāue faka'ātitá 'oku kau ai hono fakahoko e ngaahi founiga ke ma'u ai e ngaahi fakamo'oni faka'ātitá fekau'aki mo e ngaahi pa'anga mo e ngachi me'a 'oku hā 'i he ngaahi fakamatala pa'angá. Ko e ngaahi founiga na'e ngāue'aki na'e makatu'unga pē 'i he 'emau faka'uto'utá, 'o kau ai 'emau fakakaukaú'i 'a e ngaahi fehalaaki 'e ala hoko makatu'unga he fehalaaki fakafika 'o e ngaahi fakamatala pa'angá, 'o tatau pē pe ko e makatu'unga he fai hala pē fehalaaki. 'I hono fakakaukaú'i e ngaahi me'a ko ia (risks) 'e ala fehalaaki, na'a mau fakakaukaú'i e ngaahi tu'utu'uni fakaloto'i ngāue 'oku kaunga ki he teuteu 'o e ngaahi fakamatala pa'anga 'a e kautahá, 'a ia te ne 'omi 'a e tu'unga totolu mo taau'o e ngachi me'a 'oku nau fekau'aki. Na'a mau fakakau 'a e tu'utu'uni fakaloto'i ngāue, koe'uhí ke mau fokotu'utu'u ai ha sivi faka'ātitá 'oku fe'ungá, kā 'oku 'ikai 'uhinga ia ke fai ai ha lau fekau'aki mo e 'aonga 'o e ngaahi tu'utu'uni fakaloto'i ngāue 'a e kautahá.

'Oku fakakau 'i he'emu 'atitá hono vakai'i, makatu'unga hono sivi'i 'o e ngaahi fakamo'oni poupou 'o e ngaahi pa'anga mo e ngachi fakamatala 'i he ngaahi fakamatala pa'angá.

'Oku mau fakahā ne mau ma'u kotoa 'a e ngaahi fakamatala mo e fakamatala'i 'o e ngachi me'a kotoa na'a mau fiemdú. 'Oku mau tui na'e lahi fe'unga pea tacu 'a e ngaahi fakamo'oni faka'ātitá na'a mau ma'u ke makatu'unga ai 'a 'emau faka'uhinga fakā'ātitá.

Ngaahi Fatongia 'o e Poate 'a e kau Talēkitá mo e kau Pule Ngāue

Ko e mole 'e hoko ia 'o kapauko e mahu'ingalolotonga 'o e ngaahi koloa ngaue tukupau 'oku lahi ia 'i he mahu'inga 'e ala lava 'o toe ma'u mai 'i hanotukuatu. Kapau 'oku lahi e mahu'inga 'o e ngaahi koloa ngaue 'i he mahu'inga 'e ala ma'u mai, 'e lekooti leva 'a e mole pea 'oku holoki leva 'a e mahu'inga 'o e ngaahi koloa ngaue ki he mahu'inga ko ia 'e ma'u mai. Ko e katoa 'o e mole 'oku lekooti ia ko e tupu pe mole 'i he fakamatala 'o e pa'anga humai mo e ngaahifakamole. Ko e holo 'i he mahu'inga 'o e ngaahi koloa 'ikaifakapa'angamakehe, 'oku fai hono toe vakai'ifakalelei 'i he 'osi 'a e ta'ufakapa'anga ke lekooti.

### Ngaahi Koloa Fakapa'anga

Ko e kau pule ngaue 'oku nau fili'a e fakakalasi 'o e ngaahi koloa fakapa'anga 'i he taimi 'oku fuofuolekooti ai.

'Oku kau 'a e ngaahifakahu pa'anga taimitu'upau, 'inivesimeni 'i he pule'anga mo e ngaahi'inivesimeni 'ikai to e liliu 'i he kulupu ko eni.

**(c) Ngaahi no mo e pa'anga te'eki ma'u**

'Oku 'ikai ke lekooti 'e he Sino'i Pa'anga ha ngaahi pa'anga tatanaki 'oku te'eki ke ma'u mai hano foomu pe 'oku 'omai e foomu kae te'eki ke lesisita 'o makatu'unga pe 'i he 'ikai lava ke fakafuofua'i lelei 'a e palanisi 'o e pa'anga te'eki ke tanaki mai.

*Totongi Tupu Humai*

'E ngofua ke tatanaki 'e ha Memipa ha pa'anga ta'ekouna'i ki he'ene 'Akauni 'i he tu'unga mo e taimi 'e fakapapau'i mo fakaha 'e he Memipa, 'oku ha 'eni 'i he fakamatala pa'anga ko e 'AkauniTa'ekouna'i 'a e Memipa.

**(e) 'Inivesimeni 'i ha Kautaha pe Sea 'i ha Kautaha**

*Kautaha (Joint Venture)*

Ko e kautaha koeni 'oku 'ikai ko ha va'a ia 'a e Sino'I Pa'anga pe ko ha kautaha 'oku kau ki he kulupu ne fakamatala'i atu 'i he kupu 'i 'olunga (joint venture). Ko hono lekooti 'o e 'invesimeni koeni, 'oku makatu'unga pe ia 'i he founiga 'invesimeni (equity method), pea 'oku lekooti ia 'i hono mahu'ingatotonu 'i he 'ahona'e kamata ai 'a e sea 'i he kautaha ki ha 'aho 'e 'osi ai.
